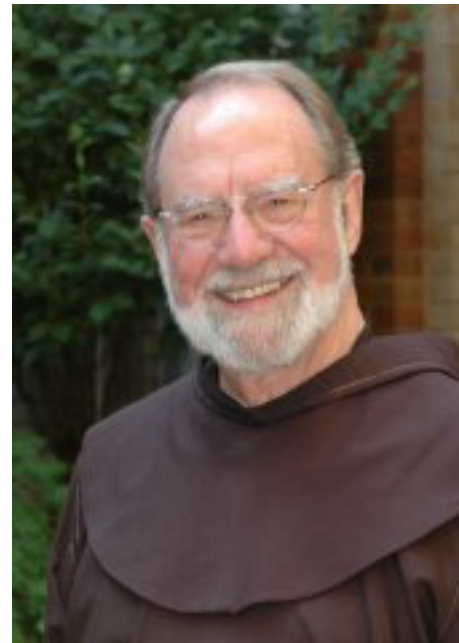

FR. THOMAS SPEIER, O.F.M., is a member of the OFM Province of Franciscans based in Cincinnati, Ohio. He founded the Franciscan Spiritual Direction Program in 1981 and for over twenty-years conducted three-month sessions in the USA, Europe, Africa and Asia. Tom was also a co-founder of the Franciscan Gathering which brought together diverse members of the Franciscan family in Tampa, Florida to explore facets of our spiritual tradition.
